Bread and Jam for Frances by Russell Hoban

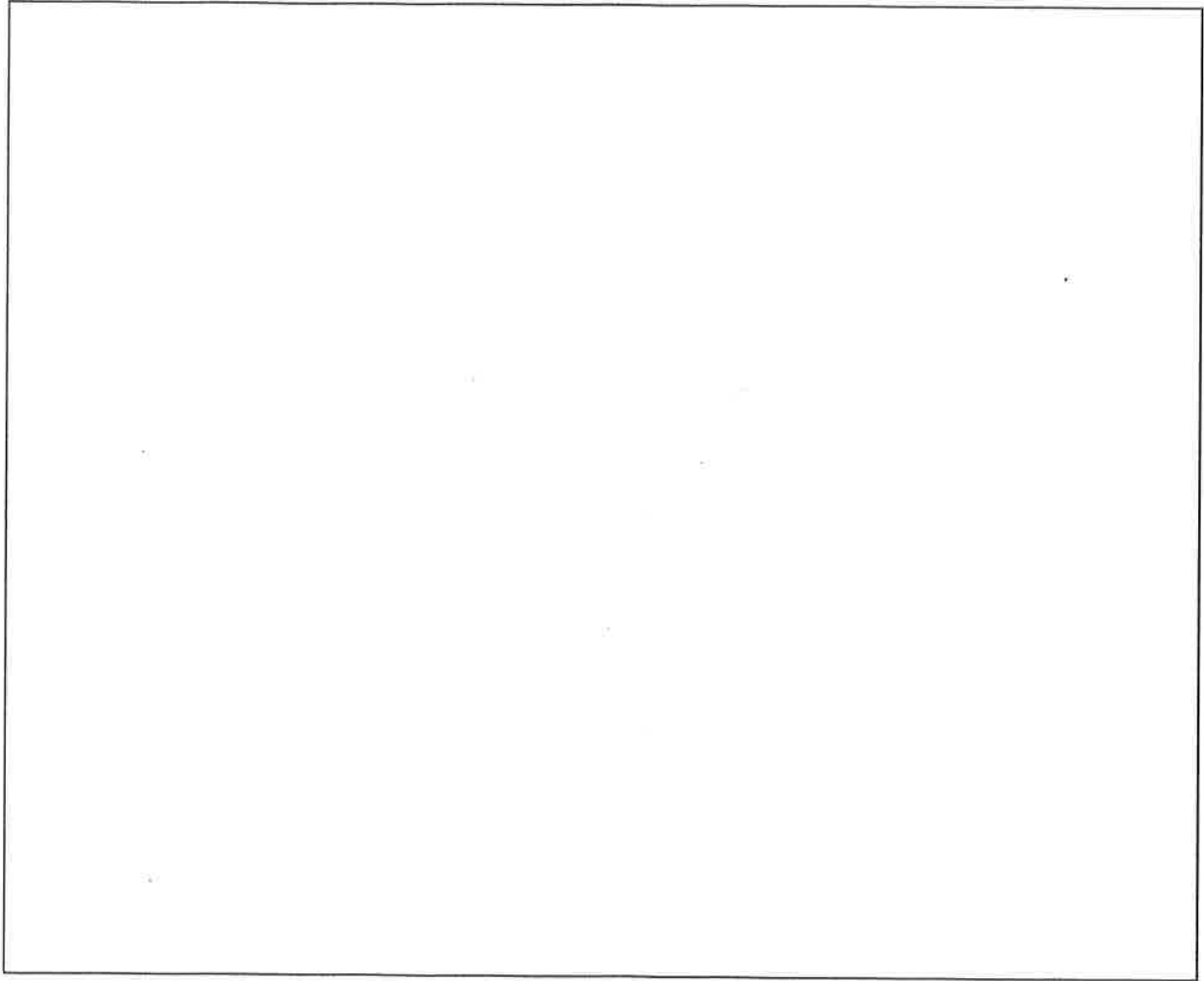
Please draw a picture from each story. It can be a picture of your favorite character, your favorite part, or your least favorite part! Please use color and thoughtful details to make it your best work.

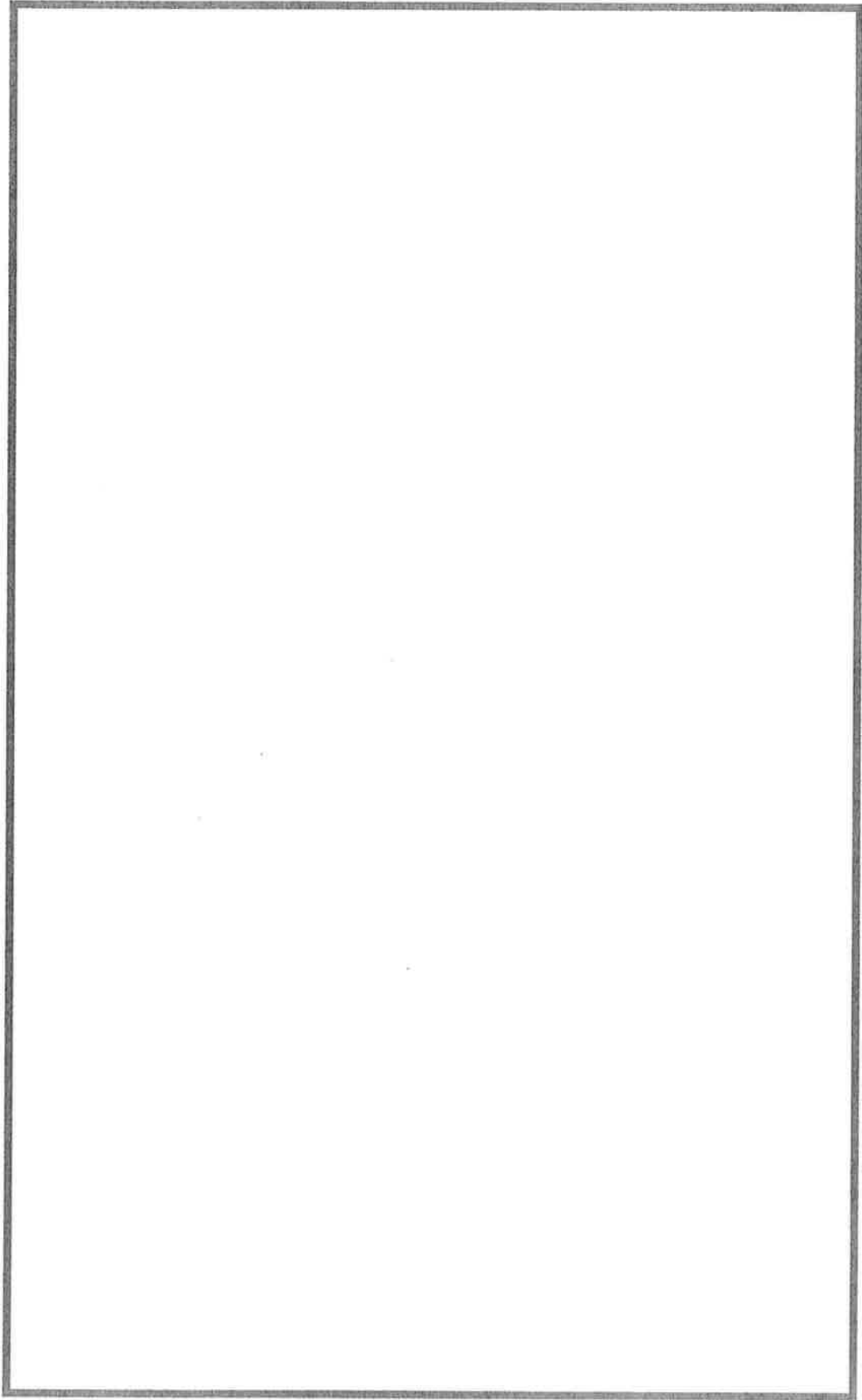
