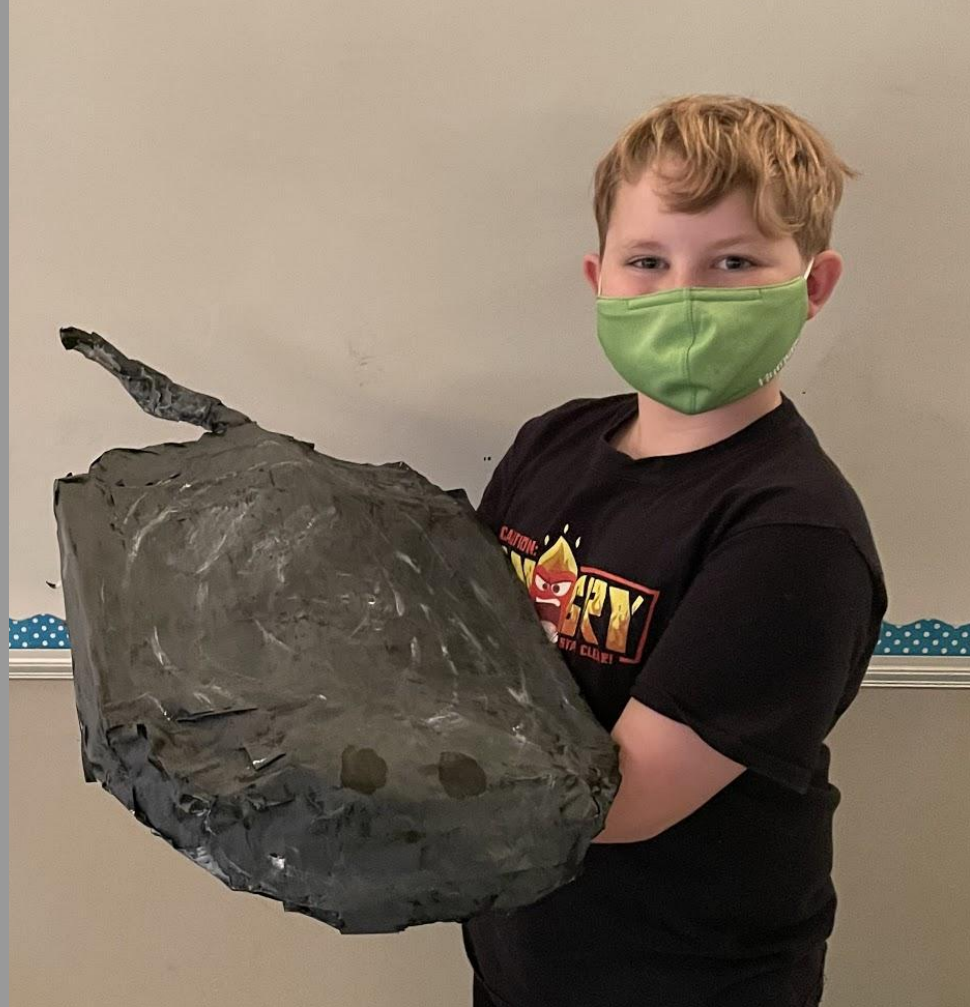
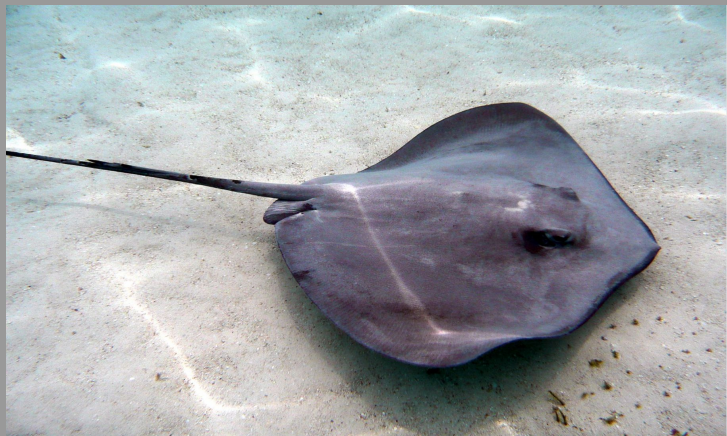


# Stingrays
