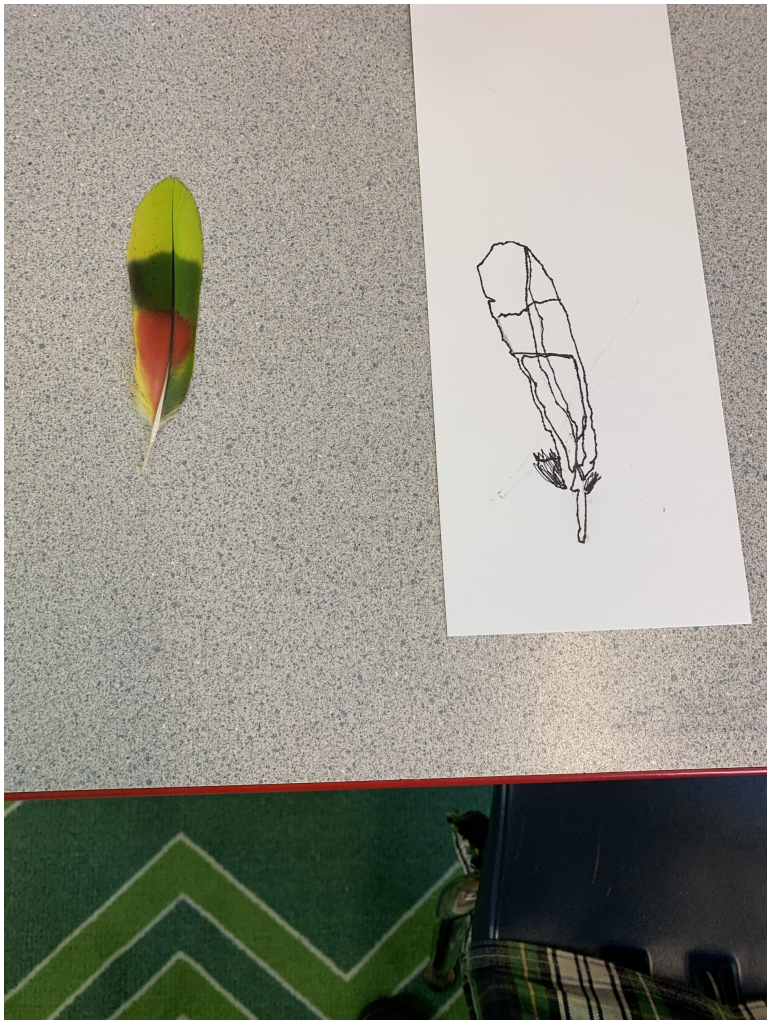
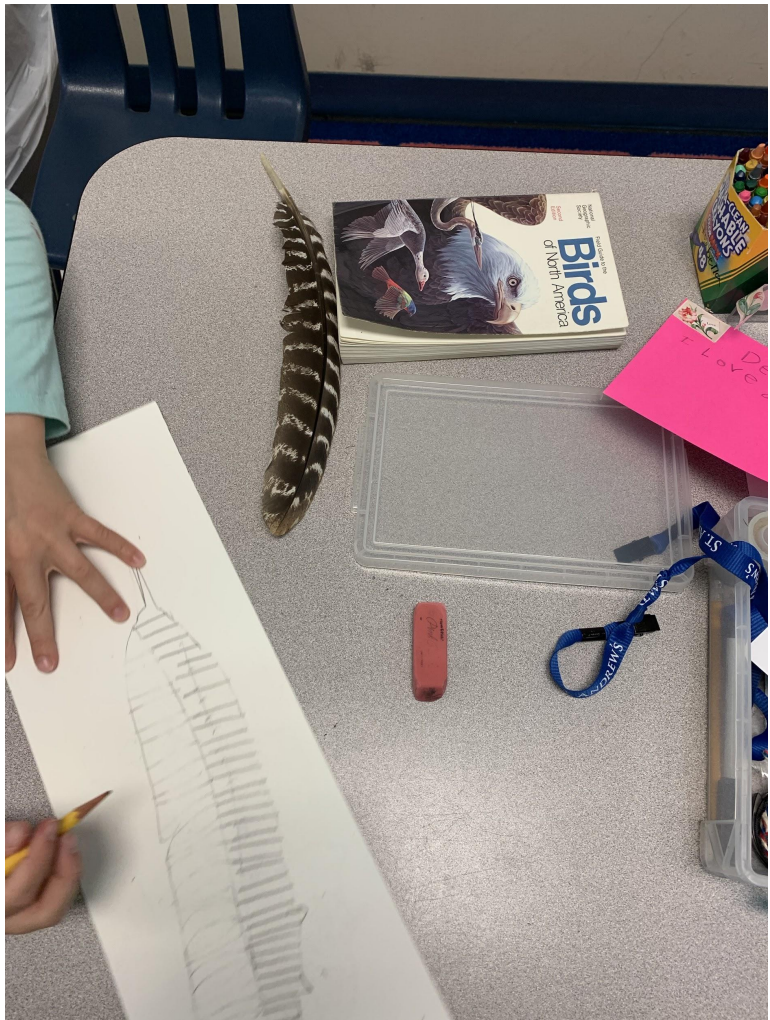
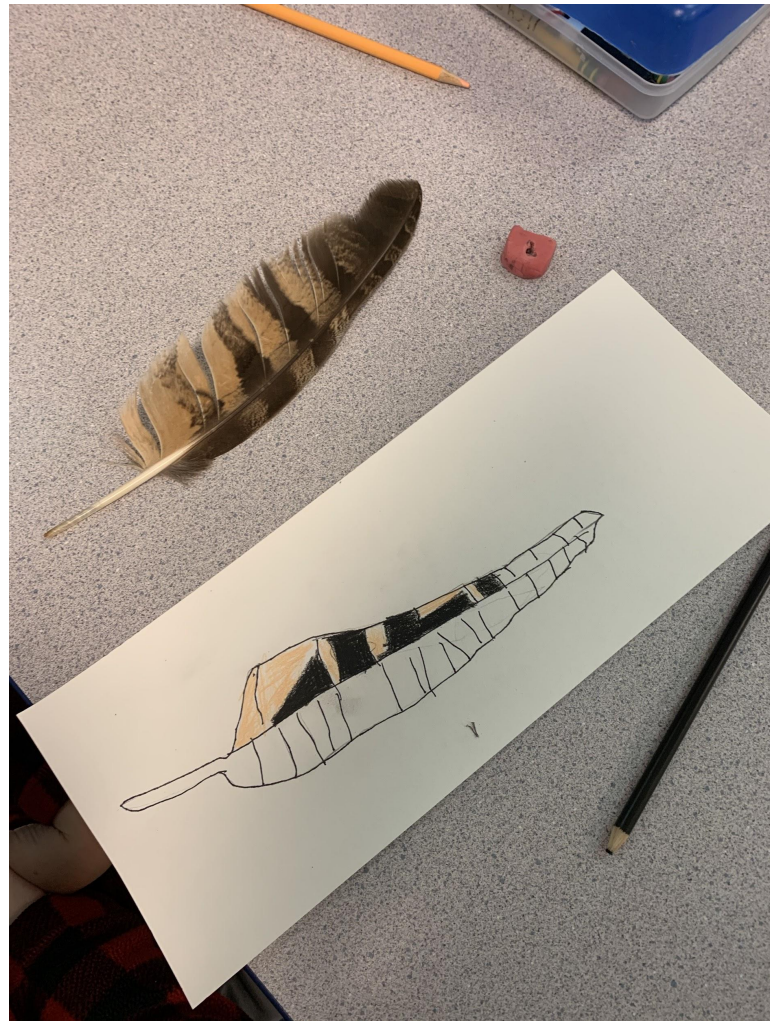
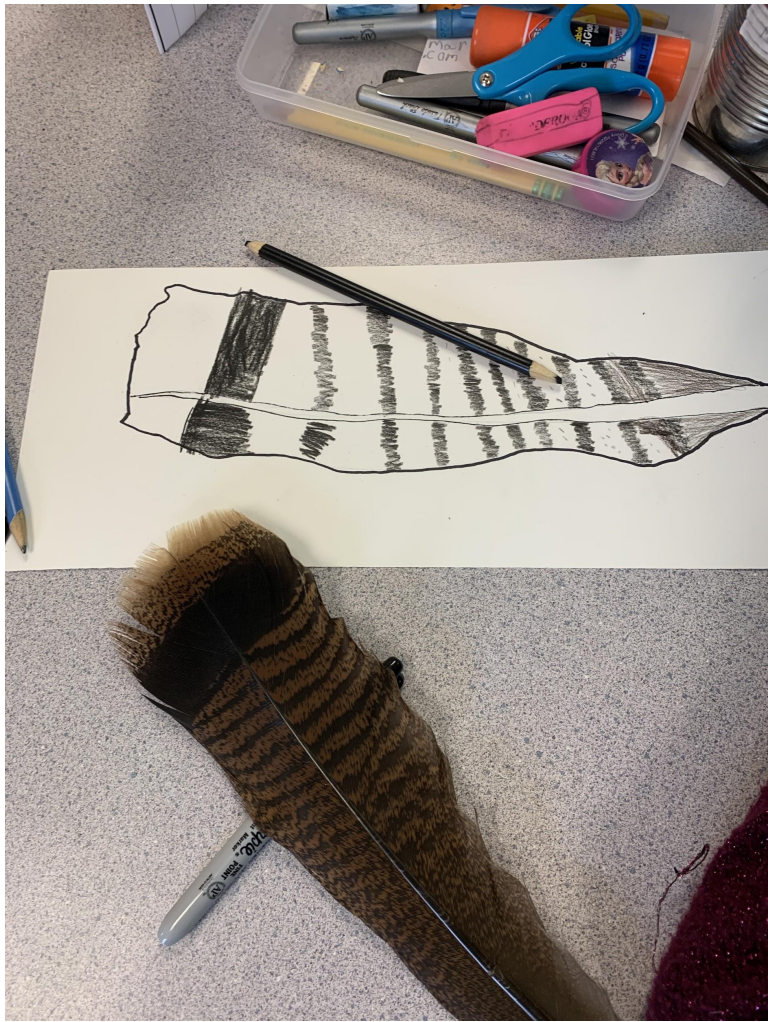


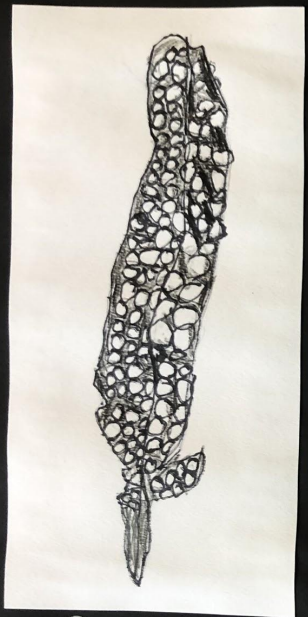
All About Feathers



What makes a bird a bird? Feathers, of course! Learning about this distinctive body feature is a key element of our bird study. 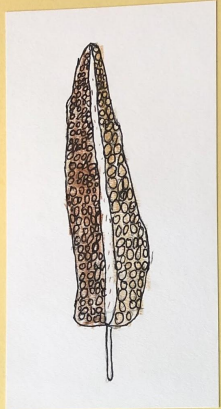

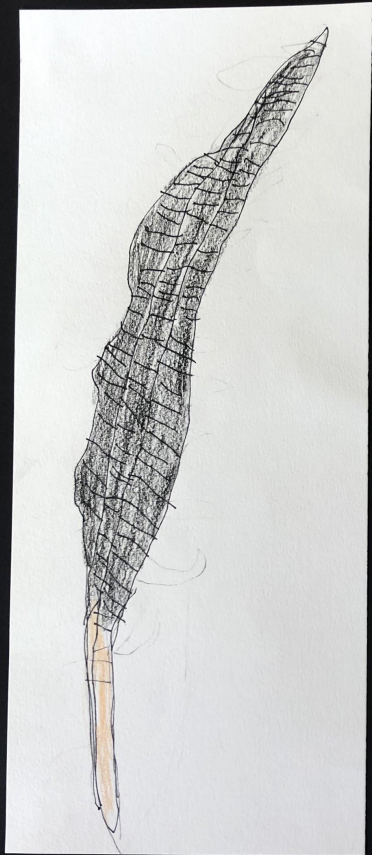
