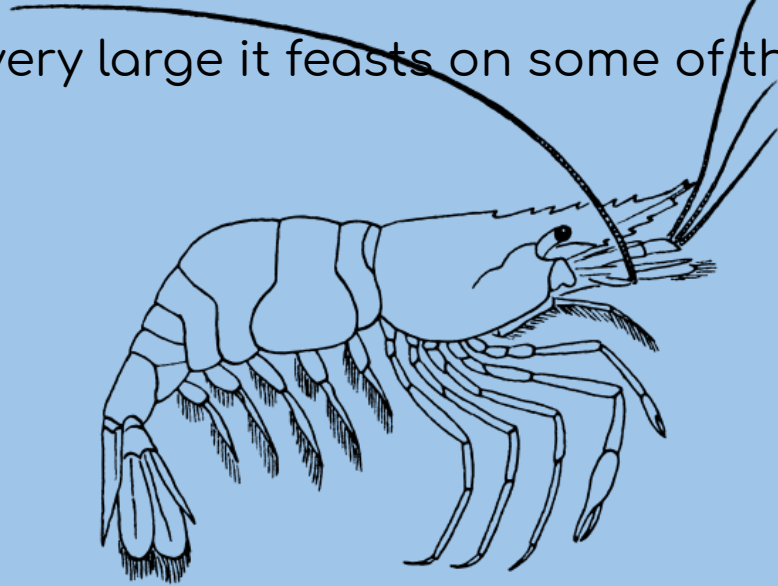
About the Animal and Habitat

- ~ Blue whales can go as deep as the Bathypelagic zone (the midnight zone.)
- ~ Underwater they look a true Blue.
- ~ Above water they look a bluish gray sorta like a old house.
- ~ They have a broad, flat head and a long, tapered body that ends in wide triangular flukes.



Diet and Predators

- ~ The blue whale has one predator which is the killer whale.

- ~ Though the blue whale is very large it feasts on some of the smallest aquatic creatures like krill.

- ~ The blue whale is the largest animal on earth.
- ~ They have loud deep voices which they use to communicate with each other from miles away.
- ~ They can swim up to thirty kilometers an hour.
- ~ Its length is about 29 meters or 98 feet.
- ~ The Blue Whale is covered with oil in order to swim swiftly through the water. (Not olive oil)
