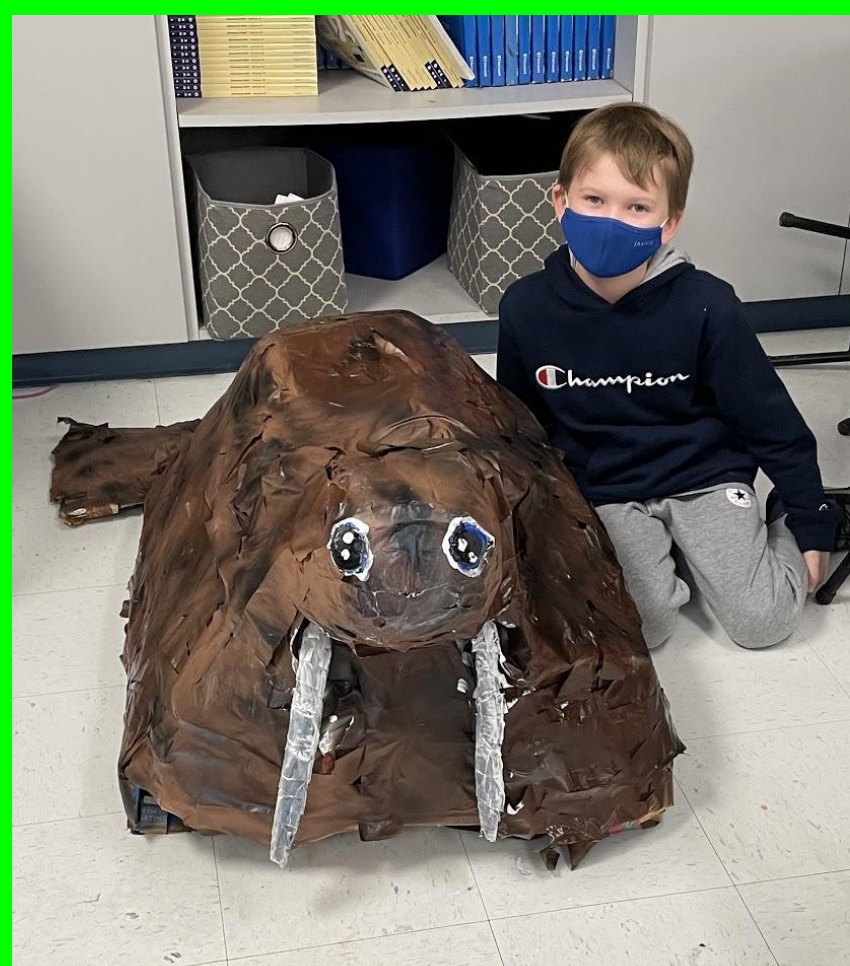


# The Walrus

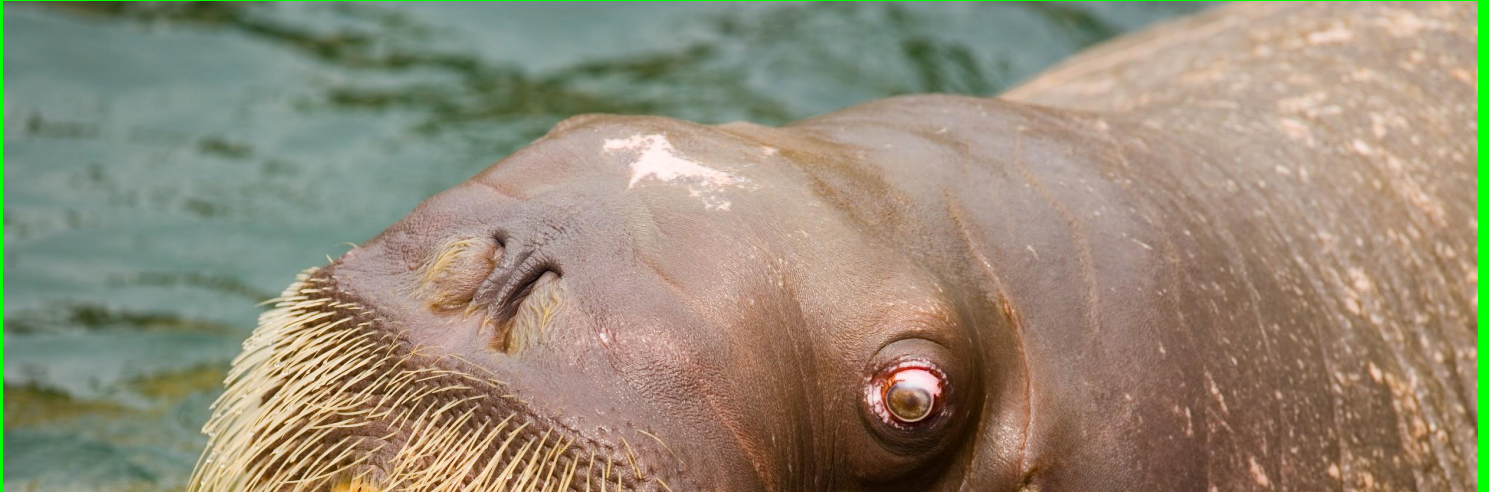
# Introduce Animal and Habitat
