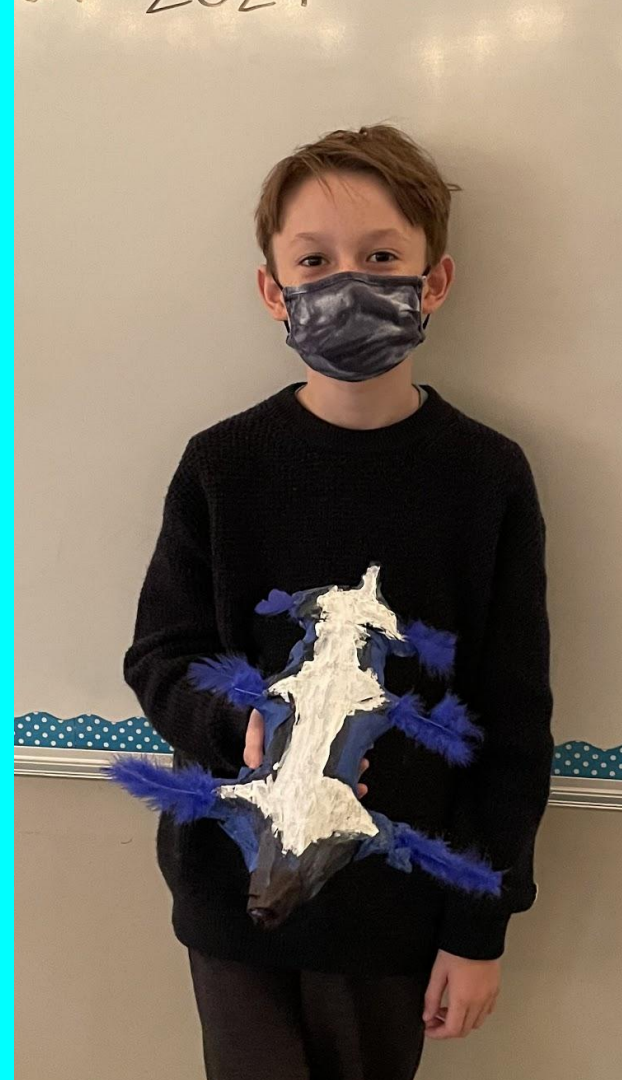


The Blue Glaucus
