Leafhopper Sea Turtles

Did you know that leafhopper sea turtles are the largest species of sea turtles in the world? They are only about three feet in length and weigh about 100 pounds compared to our hawks and other soaring birds in 1980. Their scientific name is *Stomatopoda Cnemidophorus*. Leafhoppers are considered a type of reptile, a reptile is a cold blooded animal with scales. The reason it can live on land and in water. Their average lifespan in the wild is three to five years.

This is the only sea turtle that does not have a shell and big scales. Although it does not have big scales and a shell, it does have very big fins. Their fins are like paddles to help them swim through the water. The back flippers are like a steering wheel. The sea turtles can be as long as seven feet. They can weigh up to one thousand pounds.

They eat a lot of jellyfish and sea squirts. The sea turtles go to the depths of the ocean to see their food. It has been discovered that they like to eat of sea slugs as well as hawks and slugs.
