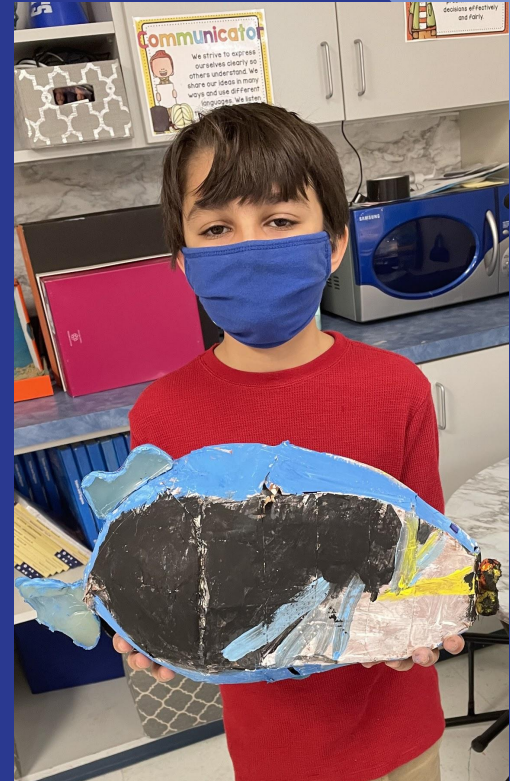


THE REEF TRIGGERFISH
