Our bird study challenges students with several important essential questions: How are organisms alike and different, how do different organisms meet their needs for survival and how can we use the observable properties of organisms to group them? For this game partners take turns pulling an animal out of the bag and deciding if they lay eggs (oviparous) or if they do not lay eggs (viviparous). First Graders learn that living things can be sorted into groups or classified by similar characteristics. And we have lots of fun in the process!
