There are only about thirty-five thousand nesting females left today compared to one hundred and fifteen nesting females in 1980. Their scientific name is Dermochelys Coriacea. Turtles are considered a type of reptile. It reptiles are cold blooded animal with scales. The name of sea lion on land and in water. There average lifespan in the wild is thirty three years.
