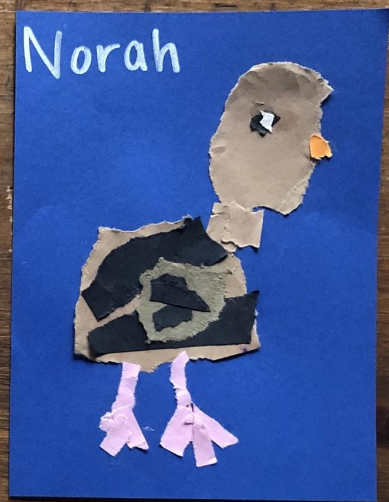
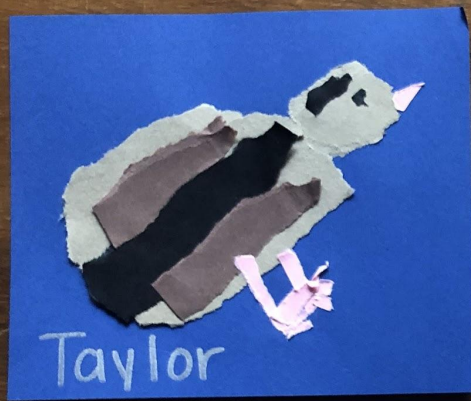


# **Torn Paper Chicks**

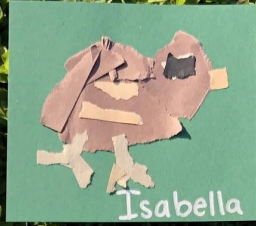
