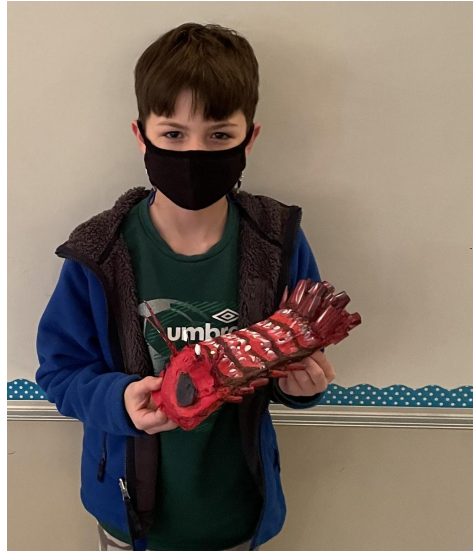


# Peacock mantis shrimp

# INTERESTING FACTS.

- ITS BODY IS SEVEN TO 12 INCHES LONG AT THE MOST
- It has six sections on its body that move
- Its a rainbow it's very colorful
- Its primary attack is 50 times faster than a blink of an eye
- Because of its very power ful and fast hammer fsts its nickname is thumb splitter
- You can only find this animal in the sunlight zone of the indian and pacific ocean
- When it sees a snack like a crab it goes full on boxes mode
- Its spend almost all of its tie in a n upright position
- It also spend most of its time usually hunting for crabs
- It is 12 grams as a baby and 90 grams when reached full size
- It only lives in approximately 72-82 degrees waters
- when it is fighting or running from bigger predators its sweeping through the coral at an average of 40-50 mph
- It lives to be 20 whole years old
- Humans don't take very good care of this animal
